Tucson Seasonal Planting Schedule

Winter (January 1 – February 15) Argula; Beet; Bok Choy; Broccoli; Brussels Sprouts; Cabbage; Carrot; Cauliflower; Celery; Chia; Chicory; Chinese Cabbage; Cilantro; Collards; Corn Salad; Escarole; Garbanzos; Garlic; Kale; Kohlrabi; Leek; Lentils; Head Lettuce; Mustard greens; Parsley; Parsnip; Peas; Radish; Rutabaga; Spinach; Swiss Chard; Turnip; Spring Wheat

Late Winter (February 15-March 15) Beet, Broccoli, Cabbage, Carrot, Cauliflower, Chinese Cabbage, Collard, Kohlrabi, Leaf Lettuce, Mustard Greens, Peas, Radish, Onion sets, Potato, Turnip, Tomato transplants (*with nighttime protection*).

Spring (March 1 – April 1) (*Plants will need nighttime protection if temperature falls below 40 degrees*) Asparagus Bean, Black-eyed Peas, Bush & Lima Beans, Collard, Sweet Corn, Cucumbers, Melons, Radish, Onion sets, Summer Herbs, Summer Squash, Winter Squash.

Late Spring (April 1 – May 15) (*Plants will need nighttime protection if temperature falls below 40 degrees.*) Amaranth, Bush Bean; Sweet Corn; Cantaloupe, Cucumber; Eggplant, Melons, Okra, Pepper Plants, Sweet Potato, Summer Squash; Tomato Plants; Tomatillas; Watermelon

Summer (June 1 – July 15) Cantaloupe, Muskmelon, Okra, (*until June 15*) Pole Bean, Summer Squash, Sweet Potato (*until June 15*). (*Pole Beans require much water*)

Late Summer (July 15 – August 25) Bush Bean; Black-eyed Pea, Pole Bean; Blue & Sweet Corn; Collards, Cucumber (*August 1-August 31*); Turnip, Summer Squash, Winter Squash (*July 1-July 31*); Pepper & Tomato Plants

Fall (September 1 – October 15) (*See January*) (*October 15 – November 15*) set out transplants of Broccoli; Cabbage, Chinese Cabbage Cauliflower; Celery; Fava Beans, Parsley. (*In early September*) Corn, Short-season Cucumber, Green Beans, Summer Squash, Tomato Plants.

Onions: Daylight Sensitive onions, September 1- October 15; Green Bunch Onions, August 15 to February 1: Onion Bulbs; Onion in Dry Seed, October 15- January 1; Onion in Dry Sets, November 1 – February 15;. Seed Potatoes planted now, to be harvested before the heat in May. January 2008
